Accademic Year 2018-19

The report outlines employer feedback regarding graduates from the 2018-2019 academic year, reflecting a generally positive assessment. Employers commend graduates for their strong analytical skills, problem-solving abilities, and leadership qualities. However, areas for improvement were identified, including the need to ensure graduates effectively apply academic knowledge in the workplace and further develop communication skills.

Q1. How well does the employee apply the academic knowledge gained from college to their current role?

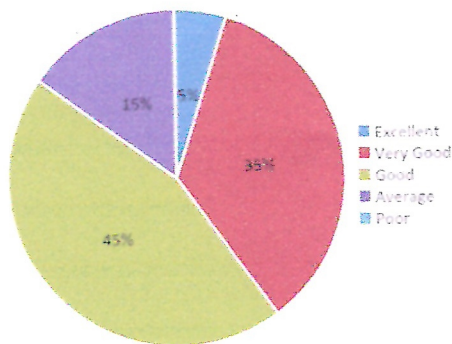

Q2. How effective is the employee's communication in the workplace, reflecting their college experience?

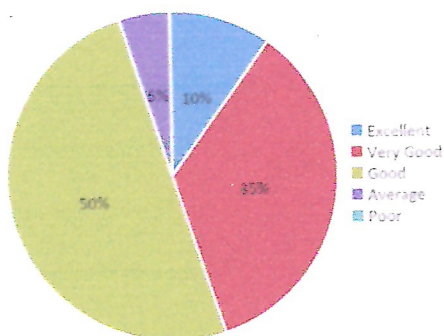

Q3. Does the employee demonstrate leadership qualities influenced by their college experiences?

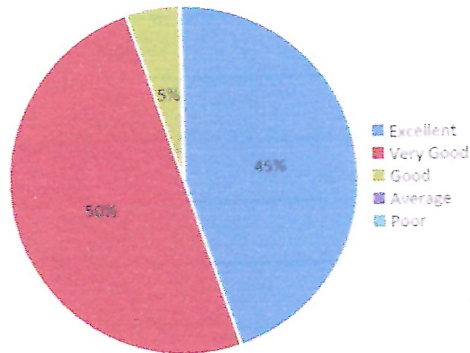

Q4. Does the employee display strong analytical skills that can be attributed to their college education?

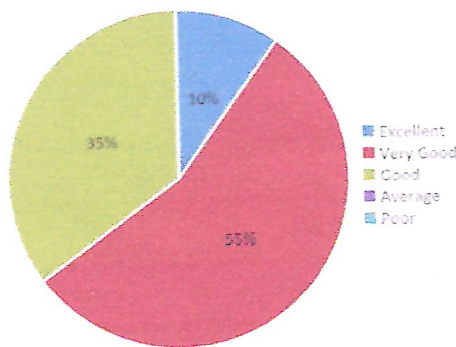

Q5. Assess the employee's problem-solving abilities as a reflection of the college's educational environment.

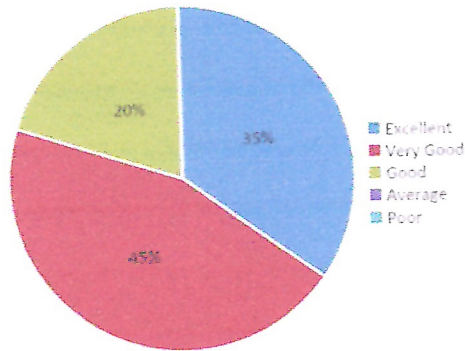

Q6. To what extent does the college's ambience influence the employees' ability to work under pressure?

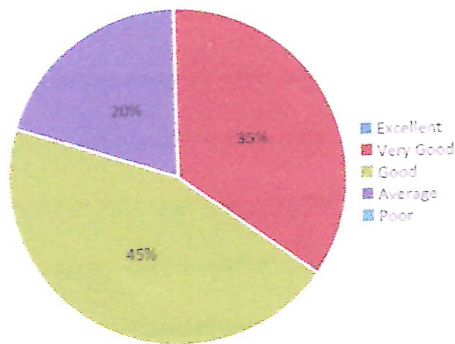

Q7. Rate how effectively the college's environment teaches students about diversity and inclusion.

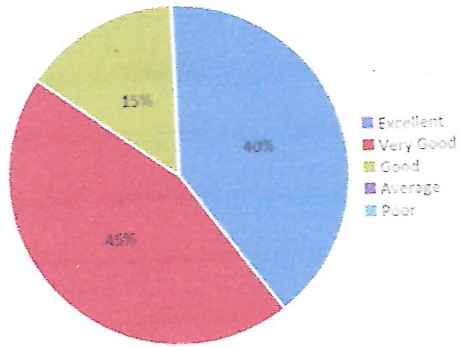
