

EMPLOYERS FEEDBACK

Academic Year 2019-20

The report analyzes employer feedback concerning graduates from the 2019-2020 academic year, highlighting both strengths and areas for improvement. Notable strengths include the college's success in instilling a strong work ethic in graduates (80% positive) and the perceived relevance of the curriculum to job skills (85% positive). However, there are areas where enhancements are needed, particularly in communication skills, where there's a gap in achieving higher ratings (65% positive). The impact of the college ambience on career development also requires attention, with only 25% rating it as "excellent" or "very good." While teamwork skills are generally well-regarded (80% positive), there's room for further development in innovation and creativity skills. Additionally, while the alignment between syllabus offerings and specialization streams is positively received (70% positive), efforts to improve overall career development within the college environment are warranted.

Q1. How effective is the employee's communication in the workplace, reflecting their college experience?

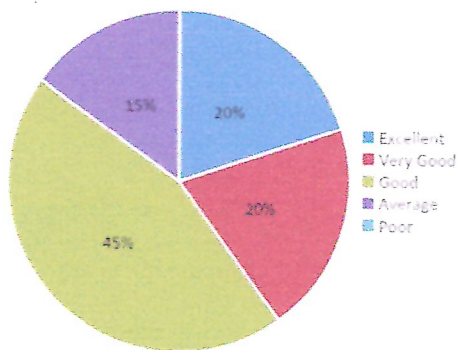

Among the employers, 20% of the employers responded Excellent, and 20% of the employers responded Very Good. 45% of the employers responded Good. 15% of the employers responded Average,

and 0% of the employers responded Poor.

Q2. Has the college's academic curriculum equipped the employee with relevant skills for their job?

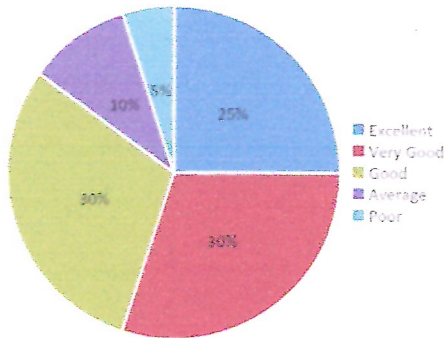

Q3. Does the employee showcase a strong work ethic that can be traced back to their college experience?

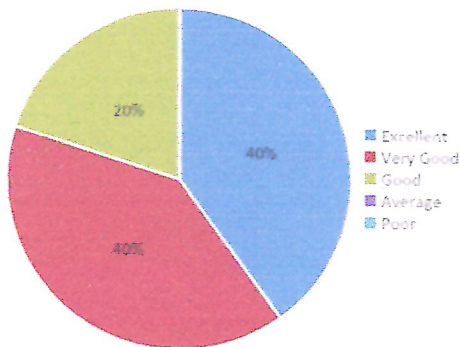

Q4. Rate the offering of the syllabus in relation to the specialization streams?

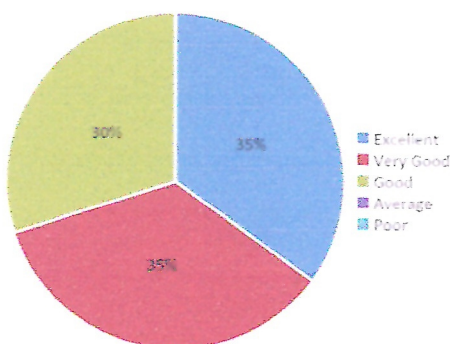


Figure 4 depicts the responses to the question, “Rate the offering of the syllabus in relation to the specialization streams?” Among the employers, 35%

Q5. Assess the overall impact of the college's ambience on employees' career development.

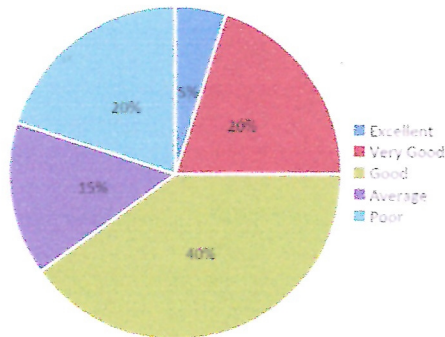

Q6. To what extent does the college's cultural environment contribute to the development of teamwork skills?

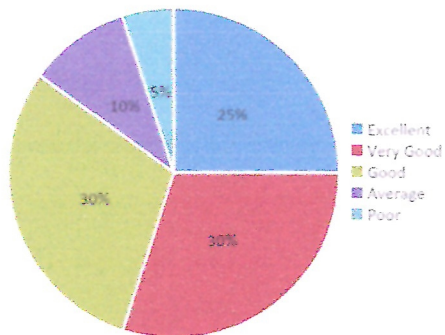

Q7. How would you rate the employee's innovation and creativity skills as influenced by their college environment?

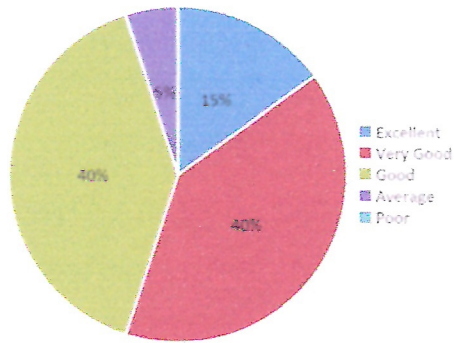
